5. What is your favorite thing about volunteering with Atlanta Track Club? What brings you back?

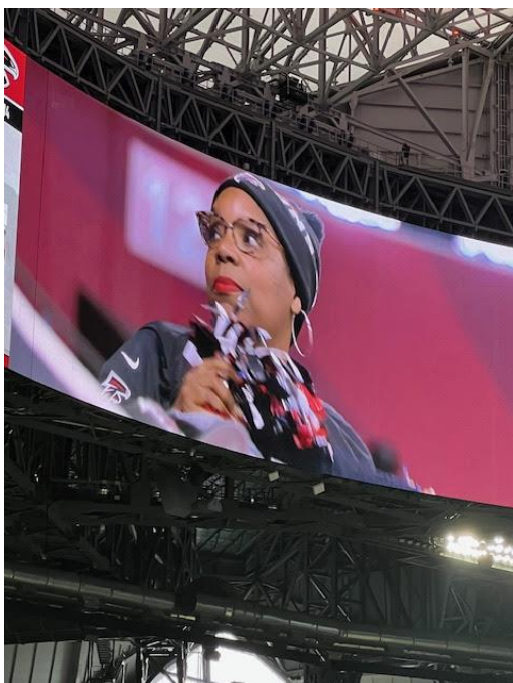
