Founded in 1975, The Family Health Centers of Georgia, Inc. (FHCGA) is a not-for-profit, 501(c)(3), federally qualified health center. FHCGA has been accredited by the Joint Commission since 2002. In 2012, we became the first community health center in Georgia, and the second in the Southeast, to be certified by The Joint Commission as a Primary Care Medical Home.

Our Mission

The Family Health Centers of Georgia provides comprehensive, high quality, patient-centered healthcare to the communities we serve, with a commitment to excellence.

Why choose a community health center? Why make FHCGA your provider of choice?

The Family Health Centers of Georgia is one of more than 1,400 Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) operating in the United States. FQHCs use healthcare delivery systems that have proven successes with improving healthcare outcomes and reducing the cost of medical services. Recent studies found that patients who regularly use health centers, like FHCGA, have lower total annual healthcare costs when compared to patients who use other primary care providers, such as HMOs, hospital outpatient units or private physicians. These studies show that the cost associated with using a FQHC is 22% to 33% less expensive, on an average, than using other healthcare models.

The managed care environment that FQHCs create increases accessibility to primary care physicians and disease management programs for Medicaid, Medicare and self pay patients. Many uninsured Americans have access to health insurance as a result of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). However, many Georgia residents do not qualify to participate in the ACA Health Insurance Marketplace or find the cost of the health plans offered in the Marketplace unaffordable. The Family Health Centers of Georgia offers a Sliding Fee Scale Program in which the fees for services are based upon meeting federally established income guidelines. FHCGA's Sliding Fee Scale Program provides an alternative payment option for uninsured and under-insured patients to receive quality medical services.

Our patients find their medical home when they choose us. They select an integrated team of healthcare providers who are either board certified or board eligible. Our professional team works with our patients and their families to address all of their healthcare needs under one roof.

- Provide access to healthcare during evening hours
- Address healthcare concerns after normal business hours
- Access to make an appointment or get medication refills, referrals, lab results, or medical advice

- Offer community resources to address all of our patient's healthcare concerns

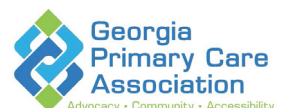
