The year 2020 marked The Family Health Centers of Georgia's 45th anniversary of providing healthcare services to medically underserved communities in metro Atlanta, and surrounding counties. What we planned as a year of celebrating our successes turned into a year of providing FREE COVID-19 testing and education to our patients & community and making sure our doors remained safely open for our patients and staff. Since 1975, The Family Health Centers of Georgia, Inc. (FHCGA), (www.fhcg.org) has established itself as an industry leader for community health centers. FHCGA was the first community health center in Georgia, and the second in the southeast, to receive Joint Commission accreditation as a Primary Care Medical Home. FHCGA operates the first school-based health center programs in Fulton, Douglas and Clayton County public school systems, which provide healthcare access to more than 175,000 students at 179 schools. FHCGA serves as the Title X family planning grant administrator for the state of Georgia; our Georgia Family Planning System has 175 healthcare sites statewide.

FHCGA has grown from one location in the historic West End Atlanta community to operating nine locations, including a 41 ft. mobile medical and dental unit, in Georgia's Clayton, Cobb, Douglas, Floyd, and Fulton Counties. FHCGA provides adult medicine, pediatrics, women's health, OB/GYN & family planning, behavioral health, vision, dental, on-site pharmacy & lab services; along with care coordination, health education and disease management programs, regardless of patient's ability to pay or health insurance status.

As we embrace 2021, we are "45+ STRONG!" and working to ensure that everyone who wants a COVID-19 vaccination or test receives it and that our uninsured and under-insured populations have access to quality healthcare.
