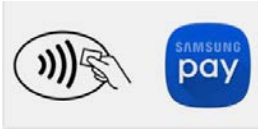


Samsung Pay Product Guide

1. Download Samsung Pay app from Google Play Store
2. Open Samsung Pay App
3. Tap MENU
4. Tap CARDS
5. Tap ADD CARD
6. Tap ADD DEBIT/CREDIT CARD
7. FI will verify card addition, once added, begin using Samsung Pay
