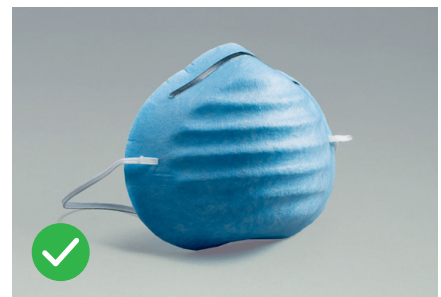

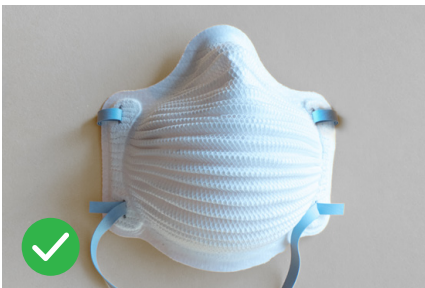
SURGICAL/PROCEDURAL MASKS (tie or ear loop)



DUST MASKS



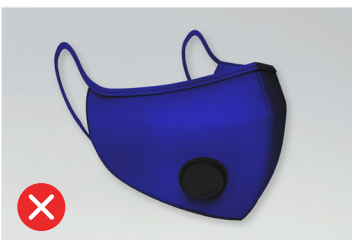
N95 MASKS WITHOUT VENTS



N95 respirators are preferred for health care personnel during specific care activities, but may be worn by patients or visitors if that is what they are wearing when they arrive to a Reid Health campus.

UNACCEPTABLE MASKS

MASKS WITH VENTS



Why? Masks with vents/exhalation valves allow unfiltered exhaled air to escape. This is an unacceptable form of source control as a universal mask while on Reid Health property.
