



Adult First Time License Checklist

The Road to Your License...the Final Mile!

Did you know that you have two options on how to use your Adult Driver Ed Completion Certificate? You can use it either to get a learner's permit if you need to practice driving OR to go ahead and take the driving test if you already know how to drive.

- Complete 6 hour online adult driver education course.**
- Complete the free one hour Impact Texas Young Drivers course.**
- Schedule your DPS Drive Test. The DPS Drive Test is conveniently offered at your local SafeWay Drive Site* or you can schedule at your nearest DPS office (at www.txdps.state.tx.us) and wait in line.**
- You will need the following items when you go to the DPS:**
 - DL-14A Form - Application for Texas Driver License
 - DL-40 Form - Supplemental Examination Form
 - ADE-1317 Completion Certificate provided by SafeWay Driving
 - IMPACT Texas Young Drivers Certificate
 - Original Birth Certificate and one copy
For Non Citizens - Valid Foreign Passport with Visa and I-94 OR
Permanent Residence card and one copy of each
 - Original Social Security Card and one copy
For Non Citizens - Social Security Affidavit form provided by DPS
 - Texas Residency Affidavit form
With two acceptable forms of proof of Texas residency
 - Glasses or contacts (if needed)
 - If you are 18 years old you may need a report card or diploma from your High School
 - If you choose to get a permit first, it will be a \$25 fee payable to the DPS.**
There will be an additional fee when you are ready to take the driving test with either SafeWay or the DPS
