



Getting Your Driver's License Checklist

The Road to Your License...the Final Mile!

-
- Drive with your permit for 6 months and turn 16
 - Complete your "Less Tears...More Years" Act 30 Hour Additional Instruction Log, with at least ten driven at night after 6:00 pm. (Remember, SafeWay offers Advanced Driving Packages that will satisfy all or a majority of these requirements while preparing you for today's roads.)
 - Complete the free 2 hour Impact Texas Teen Drivers (ITTD) course.
 - Schedule your DPS Drive Test. The DPS Drive Test is conveniently offered at your local SafeWay Drive Site* or you can schedule at your nearest DPS office (at www.txdps.state.tx.us) and wait in line.
 - DPS REQUIRED ITEMS for Teen Driver License:**
 - DPS Drive Test appointment (schedule with SafeWay today!)
 - DPS Copy of Green DEE-964 Certificate labeled "For Driver License Only" (**signed and dated before completion of ITTD course**)
 - Completed 30 Hour Additional Instruction Log
 - IMPACT Texas Teen Drivers (ITTD) Completion Certificate
 - Street Legal Automobile w/Proof of Insurance
 - Glasses or contacts (if needed)
 - Valid Learner's Permit
 - Original US Birth Certificate or US Passport
 - Original Social Security Card
 - NEW VOE (Verification of Enrollment) Form from your High School
 - \$11.00 Driver License Fee (subject to change)
 - Parent or Legal Guardian
 - Put your cell phone away and drive the SafeWay!**
