AVOID FESTIVAL TRAFFIC CONGESTION BY ARRIVING FROM THE NORTH
The Texas Renaissance Festival Prepares to Close Out the 2019 Season

Nov. 26, 2019 (Todd Mission, TX) – As the Texas Renaissance Festival prepares to close out the 2019 season, festival management continues to encourage festival visitors to arrive at the festival from the North to avoid traffic congestion due to road construction on SH 249 and FM 1774.

I-45 North – Exit SH 105 West at Conroe continue on to Plantersville where you will turn left at FM 1774 which will bring you to the festival gates.

SH 290 North – Exit SH 6 East towards Bryan/College Station, Exit SH 105 East towards Plantersville. At FM 1774 turn right and arrive at the festival.

Once you are on the main roads such as FM 1488 and FM 1774, do not take alternate routes suggested by travel apps such as Waze and Google, as diverting to side roads creates additional traffic congestion with people trying to re-enter onto the main roads.

The Texas Renaissance Festival will close out its 45th season this weekend with Celtic Christmas on Thanksgiving Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. – 8 p.m. each day. Highlights of the weekend will include photos with Santa Claus, a pumpkin pie eating contest at 4 p.m. and Vendor Appreciation Weekend. Purchase \$250 in merchandise from festival vendors (food and drink excluded), show your paper receipt at the Festival Information Booth and receive two Any Day tickets for the 2020 season.
