Attached is the application for The Texas Renaissance Participant Scholarship. This \$1,500 scholarship is available to current college students or graduating seniors in public, private, and home schools who work for the Texas Renaissance Festival or one of its vendors for the entire 2019 season. Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or eligible resident.

Scholarship Information:

1. Students must be planning to attend a college, university, or trade school in the fall of 2020.
2. Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - 40% academic
 - 20% extracurricular involvement, including participation in school activities such as sports or arts; or service organizations such as school student council or tutoring initiatives, local food banks or animal shelters, etc.
 - 20% recommendations, including official rubric from TRF employer
 - 20% essays
3. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college or university in which the recipient enrolls.
4. Applications may be obtained by going to www.texrenfest.com.
Follow the links to the New Application and print out the on-line information and application. All applications, recommendation letters, and transcripts **must** be returned to the festival office **by April 1, 2020**.
Only **completed** applications will be considered (all essays, recommendations and official transcripts must be included).
6. Recipients will be announced by May 1, 2020.
7. The application is confidential, for exclusive use of the scholarship committee.
